

Reminders

Hey all, just a few Rewards reminders here:

Our best bud, Jennifer, who handles all our Reward forms and Memberships has lately been getting swamped with Redemptions that have no Certificates attached. You must have your Reward Certificate attached (thin sheet of paper) or else LIFE cannot accept it. No Certificate, no Gift Card or other Redemption!! Point taken.

We've said this a few times, but for those who are new or have forgotten: Renewal Points can not be claimed on the point forms. Members will receive a Certificate in the mail indicating you have automatically received your points. This Certificate is to be used when you redeem your points. When you try to claim Renewal Points on your Point Form, it's the same as 'double-dipping' - trying to get the points for Renewing twice. And that is grounds for Member termination, and we don't want that happening, so PLEASE - simply Renew - wait for your Certificate in the mail - then attach it to your Reward Certificate when you claim points. It's that easy.



On another note, here's a great way to play the song "Paper Moon" ("It's Only a Paper Moon"). Follow the directions below and you will get a wonderful jazz guitar accompaniment:

- 1. Press the Swing style button
- 2. Go to the variation called "San Frans"
- 3. Press the Alter Style button
- 4. Turn off the Orch Plus button
- 5. Increase the Tempo to 120 +/-
- 6. To start, use Intro 2 or just play the 1st chord of the song and hold the FX for 2 measures.
- 7. Lastly, for an ending, press either Intro/Ending 1 or 2. Enjoy!
