

Baseball Season

Baseball season is here so call for the delivery truck and move your Lowrey down to the ballpark.

Last year the St. Louis Cardinals won the series with Dwayne Hilton playing the Lowrey at Busch Stadium. Who knows, maybe this year the Cubs will bring home the pennant if

we all play this song during the 7th inning stretch along with Gary Pressy, the Lowrey organist at Wrigley Field? And let's not forget that Dean Rosko plays a Lowrey up in Milwaukee at Miller Park. The Brewers have an excellent chance this year and Dean could make Lowrey part of yet another World Series celebration. Be they Cubs, Cards, Brewers or your favorite team, give them a boost with this easy version of "Take Me Out to the Ballgame,"

- 1. To hit a home run with your listeners, press General Preset #3, AOC, and Easy.
- 2. At the end of the 3rd line, hold the long "G" note with your "pinky" finger and use your thumb, index, & thumb again to play the "stems down" notes.
- 3. Don't forget to slide down and back up the keys at the glissando markings.
- 4. Play the last note of the song loud and then quickly pull back the volume pedal. Slowly cresendo up to about ½ volume and then just before you release the melody note (and press the **Easy** button to silence the chord), quickly press that volume pedal to full volume.

When you press the **Easy** button, the **MCS** (Music Chord System) will automatically come on. With **MCS** on, you can play the following chords as follows:
