

Blessed Assurance	Style: Bog Waltz or Big Band Waltz – Tempo 68 +/- , Turn Off Genie & Orch Plus Golden Harp: Guitar Pattern, Genius=Guitar: Acoustic #115 (or select EZ Waltz in place of Golden Harp) Preset: Category "Country" #1 No Intro, just let the Golden Harp pattern play 4 bars.
Softly and Tenderly	Style: Smooth Piano 4/4 or EZ 4/4 – Tempo 85 +/-, Touch "Edit Style" and then turn Off Orch+3 Preset: Rhythm Preset #0 – Use Intro & Ending 2
I Love To Tell The Story	Style: Heart Songs or Soft Gospel – Tempo 88 +/- , Use Intro & Ending 2 Preset: Rhythm Preset #8
When We All Get To Heaven	Style: Mr. Showman – Tempo 108 +/-, Use Intro & Ending 2 Preset: Rhythm Preset #0
'Tis So Sweet To Trust In Jesus	Style: Pop Piano or Soft Gospel – Tempo 88 +/- , Use Intro & Ending 2 Preset: Rhythm Preset #0
In the Garden	Style: Guitars 3/4 w/Intro & Ending 1 – Tempo 88 +/- , or Easy Waltz (Alter) w/Intro & Ending 2 Preset: Rhythm Preset #0

I'll Fly Away	Same as the above Make this song a medley by playing "Are You Washed " and at the end add a C7 chord. Then press & hold FX until you can turn back to page 11. Play "I'll Fly Away" in cut-time (half-note = 1 beat)
What A Friend We Have In Jesus	Style: Guitars 4/4 or Easy 4/4 (Alter) (No Intro) – Tempo 72 +/-, Start style and after 1 or 2 bars press FX (Fill) to start the song. Preset: Rhythm Preset #8
Standing On The Promises	Style: EZ Country – Tempo 110 +/-, Intro & Ending 2, Touch "Edit Style" and turn Off Orch+ 1 Preset: Rhythm Preset #0
Turn Your Eyes Upon Jesus	Style: Smooth Piano 4/4 & Rhythm Preset #0 – Tempo 98 +/-, Turn Off Orch+ and Memorize to Bank Preset A-2 (with Style). Now turn Off style & press Easy button. Memorize to Bank Preset A-1 (with Style). Start the song with no rhythm using A-1. At the lyric "Turn" (page 25), use A-2 & play to the end with repeats. Press Ending 2 to end song.
Leaning On The Everlasting Arms	Style: Roadside Café – Tempo 112 +/-, Intro & Ending 1 or 2. On the Keypad, press #1 and touch the Genie button (Puts a Piano sound in the Genie). Turn Off Orch Plus. Preset: Country #9 (Floyde's Pianos)
The Old Rugged Cross	Style: Smooth Orch 3/4 (Alter Style) or EZ 4/4 – Tempo 85 +/-, Intro & Ending 1. Touch "Edit Style" and turn Off everything except Orch+ 1. Also turn Off the Genie. Preset: Rhythm Preset #8.
How Great Thou Art	Style: EZ 4/4 (Alter Style) – Tempo 90 +/-, Intro & Ending 2. Turn Off Orch Plus for the verses but back on for the Refrain. Preset: Rhythm Preset #0
I Want To Stroll Over Heaven With You	Style: Southern 3 / 4 or Country Waltz – Tempo 85 +/-, Intro & Ending 2. Preset: Rhythm Preset #8
