
Kimball Pipes

The Michiana Music For L.I.F.E. Chapter, sponsored by Shirks Piano and Organ of Mishawaka, IN, recently attended a fabulous organ concert featuring famed artist Bob Ralston. Mr. Ralston was the first major artist to perform on the newly restored 1924 Kimball theatre pipe organ re-installed at the Lerner Theatre in Elkhart, IN.



A crew of 20 from the Bunn-Minnick Pipe Organ Company of Columbus, OH spent three weeks hoisting and installing equipment, including filling the two pipe chambers with more than 1,000 rebuilt pipes and apparatus. The entire project consumed nearly 10,000 work hours for the crew over the course of a year. Decribed by Minnick as the 'Crown Jewel' of the old theatre, the project rescued one of only three organs of this Kimball type that reside in their original theatre in the U.S.

Mr. Ralston performed a flawless concert interjected with many humorous stories from his career playing with the Lawrence Welk Orchestra and his collaboration with other entertainers.



Not only were those in attendance wowed by the magnificent sound of the fully restored pipe organ, but also by Mr. Ralston's mastery of the instrument. For more information about the restoration of the Lerner Theatre visit the web site www.thelerner.com.
