



This title, and many more of our favorites are found in the song book, John Williams-16 Classics. We hope you enjoy this setup and the setups offered on the facing page for the other titles. Let's give it a go!

Raider's March


- Style: Out There Ballad or 8-Beat Rock or Grand March: Tempo 110 Turn off the Basic & Orch. Plus or bring the Style volume all the way down. When using 8-Beat Rock, a little bit of Style volume should be OK but keep it soft.
- Models: Marquee, Rialto, Journey

Features: Virtual Orchestra Category Setups, MCS+, Lower Left/Right keyboard


Setup:


- Select Category Setup "Virtual Orchestra" #10 (Fanfare /Fr. Horn) or "Lush" #10 (Lush Brass). On the Journey that's General Setup #8. Basically, you want Strings: Ensemble 1 plus Brass Ensemble on the upper keyboard.
- Harmony = Octave or Full AOC, AOC, or Duet. Turn on MCS+ (adjust Lower Volume).
- 3. On the Marquee or Rialto press "Left" in the ORCH. 2 section and turn the ORCH. 2 volume down to 3 red lights +/-.

Performance: Intro button = **OFF**. Begin with the written introduction as follows:



- 1. When you play the 1st "C" chord the style will begin. If you set Orch. 2 to "Lower Left", try to continue playing the rhythm pattern above with your left hand when on the 1st page.
- 2. Play all eighth notes on the 1st page like the last two notes shown above (except the E to D notes in both Ending 1 and 2). Listen to the original recording and mark where they play this rhythm in your music. You'll also hear that some 8th notes should be 16th notes (like the first two notes in the 2nd measure of the 2nd page). Mark those as well by adding another line to make the 8th notes look like 16th notes.
- 3. Play and mark all Bb chords as Bbmaj7 (Bb + A when MCS is on).
- 4. CODA: Play all Gm chords as Bbmaj7 chords.
- 5. In the very last measure, press the style's Stop button and play the last 4 notes on the upper keyboard with an octave lower note and a pedal as follows:

16	<i>Hedwig's Theme</i> (Alter Style)	Doris 3 / 4 Tempo 150 +/- Alter Style	Use Vintage #5 (Toy Piano). No Intro but let style play & then come in. 2nd note pg. 2 = Lower Right. Go to Upper end of line 3. Use Ending 1.
18	Theme from Jurassic Park	Easy Button Opt.: Golden Harp: Tempo 80	Use Bank D4 & begin on the Lower Right. 3rd pg. 2nd line, go to Upper. 4th pg. 2nd line , #8 . 4th pg. Last line, #9.
23	Olympic Fanfare and Theme	Grand March Tempo 82 +/-	Use Category: Brass #7 Old Brass/Horns + AOC Octave on Upper. Use Fr. Horns on the Lower Right to contrast 16th notes on the upper.
26	Moonlight	Chillin' at MJ's Tempo 88 +/-	Use Vintage #4 and then #9 after the 2nd Ending. Lower the Drum Volume 2 and Lock Accomp. Use "Fill Start/End" to begin and end the song.

38	Somewhere In My Memory (from Home Alone)	Country Blessing Tempo 88 +/- Drum Volume: Off	Use Category Lush #4 & turn ON Lower Harmony. <u>Accomp. Lock On</u> . Play 1st 4 bars w/chords only as Intro and1st three lines on the Lower Right. Then go to Upper to the end. Press Ending 2.
40	Star Wars (Main Theme)	Grand March Tempo 90 +/-	Use Vintage Style Setup #10 and either Intro. End of the 3rd line, go to #4 . 1st bar, 2nd pg., line 3, press #10 . Don't play the last bar, press Ending 2, and play the last bar on the 2nd bar of the ending.
42	Theme from Superman	Grand March Tempo 90 +/- No "Intro" button Use Ending 2	Use Bank D10 (press Solo Octave). Hold C pedal & Play 4th pg. on Lower Right. Go to Upper on the "G" chord (style starts). Go to 1st pg. at end of 4th line. Use D9 for 2ndpg. Go to D10 last line, 3rd pg.
46	The Throne Room (and End Title)	Grand March Tempo 90 +/-	Use Bank D10 & at the Repeat sign (Pg. 1) to D9 . Last page, 2nd line, 2nd note, go to D10 . Ending 2.
50	With Malice Toward None	Easy Button	Use Bank D6 . For ORCH. 2: Key #188 & touch "SOUNDS", turn on Upper & set Volume to max.
52	When You're Alone	Moon Stream 3/4	Use Normal 0 , Intro & Ending 2, & Lower Right.
