



Song Setups by: Bil Curry

Wikipedia states that Carole King is the most successful female songwriter of the latter half of the 20th century in the USA, having written or co-written 118 pop hits on the Billboard Hot 100 between 1955 and 1999. Here are setups for the 16 songs, all in Easy Play notation, featured in the Carole King songbook.



I Feel The Earth Move

Featured Model: EY320 Journey

Setup: Memphis Piano (Rock-Pianist-1st selection)
Tempo 114 +/- (original recording was 120+)

Sound: Use Style Setup 0 (“Normal” button on the larger Lowrey models)
Set the Drum Volume to its maximum level (or close to maximum)
You can also play the song using the 8-Beat Rock style (Basic Rock on older models).

Performance: Intro button = OFF.

1. Begin playing just the chords as follows (arrow shows where the G7 is played):

Chord progression: Dm | Play G7 just after the 2nd beat | G7 | Dm | Dm

Beats: 1 2 3 4 | 1 2 3 4 | 1 2 3 4 | 1 2 3 4

1. G7 | 2. G7 Melody: A G F

2. If you're using the Memphis Piano style, on the 2nd page, line 3, in the last measure: HOLD the Fill (Left Footswitch). Write "Hold Fill" in the music. Release the Fill in the last bar of the 1st line on the next page (mark it as "Fill Off").
3. To end, press Ending 1 after repeating the last 4 measures. On the largest Lowrey units, when you repeat those last 4 measures, press Fade Out.

More: For the Memphis Piano style, you may prefer to use the **Alter Style**. If you do, turn Alter Style off for the sections that start with the lyrics "Ooh ba - by" and "Ooh dar - lin".
