"The Entertainer" is a 1902 classic piano rag written by Scott Joplin. It was sold first as sheet music, and then in the 1910s as piano rolls that would play on self-playing pianos. As one of the classics of ragtime, it returned to international fame as part of the ragtime revival in the 1970s, when it was used as the theme music for the 1973 Oscar winning film *The Sting*. *The Sting* is an American caper film set in September 1936, involving a plot by two professional grifters to con a mob boss. Thanks to the film and its score, Joplin's work became appreciated in both the classical and popular music worlds, becoming a classical phenomenon.

**Style:** <u>Joplin Stride</u> or 2-Beat Piano . . . older units use Basic Foxtrot or <u>Basic Ragtime</u> (with Tempo = 64 + /-).


**Style Setup:** 0 (zero) - Piano on upper

**Tempo:** 120 +/- (Do not use the Intro button)

Upper Keyboard: If you can, use both hands to play this intro with the left hand playing one octave lower.

Hint: Play the notes the way you hear the song in your head.
